Official nomination (email nomination is fine) from the home institution confirming the student's participation in the exchange program.</li> <li>2. Completed application form</li> <li>3. Academic transcript</li> <li>4. Copy of passport</li> </ol> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- No application fee is required</li> <li>- Application, transcript and passport can be submitted via email</li> <li>- No English language proficiency assessment is required; however, Host institution should be confident in student's English language ability</li> </ul>

Instead follow the steps below.</b></p> <p>Step 1: Visit the academic timetable on the Registrar's website (<a href="https://central.acadiau.ca/registrar/timetable">https://central.acadiau.ca/registrar/timetable</a>)</p> <p>Step 2: Under 'Main Search' select your desired 'Session', 'Faculty', and 'Discipline' and click 'View Courses'. View the course description by clicking on course number.</p> <p>Step 3: Record the 'Course', 'Section', and 'Title' of each course for which you want to register.</p> <p>Step 4: Email the 'Course', 'Section' and 'Title' information to Lisa Davidson in the Registrar's Office at <a href="mailto:lisa.davidson@acadiau.ca">lisa.davidson@acadiau.ca</a></p> <p>Step 5: Expect an email from Lisa that will confirm that you are registered for your selected courses.</p>

Please plan your arrival on these dates. You must register for this on the International Website at least three weeks in advance.</p>
