Housing	<p>Incoming students should arrange accommodation on their own, but can receive assistance by the Department of International Affairs.</p> <p>The average rent per month for a furnished room/apartment in Aachen can range between 250,00 € and 400,00 €. Additionally, a security deposit of two-months-rent is required.</p>
Monthly Costs of Living	<p>Cost of living approximately 800,00 € per month (incl. housing, food, entertainment, books, transport and personal expenses)</p>
Additional Fees	<p>Administrative fee (no tuition fee) of approx. 250,00 € per semester obligatory for enrolment (includes a ticket for free public transport in the Federal State of Northrhine-Westphalia (NRW), a student activity fee and a university accident insurance)</p>
Health Insurance Requirements	<p>Valid health insurance required for enrolment, can be purchased after arrival in Germany, approx. 70,00 € per month. A travel insurance for the first two weeks is recommended as the student health insurance only becomes valid after enrolment.</p> <p>EU-citizens should bring their European Health Insurance Card (EHIC-Card)</p>
